It may further be noted that all the above-mentioned deficiencies are required to be rectified by 31st May 2000 for consideration of resturation of intake proportionately (minimum of 75% required faculty in the relevant discipline should be appointed by 31ct May 2000 for restoration of intake only).

However, your institution is also found to be suffering from the deficiencies mentioned below which need to be rectified by 31st August 2006

Note: The mandatory disclosure in prescribed format if not costed on the website should be hosted by 31st May, 2006, falling which action would be nitiated as per the rules and regulations of the AICTE including No Admission / Withdrawal of approval.

The institution is required to submit two copies of the Cranpliance Feport, indicating the rectification of deficiencies along with mandatory disclosure and details of faculty recruited for each course in the prescribed format (available at AICTE Website www.sigte.emet.in) to the concerned Regional Office latest by 31st August 2006 for consideration of approval seyond the session 2006-07.

The Compliance Report must be accompanied with a processing fee of Rs. 40,000/- in the form of demand draft in the favour of Member Secretary, ACTE, payable at New Delhi. In the absence of processing fee the Compliance Report will not be entertained. Following the Compliance report, the Council would verify the status in respect of rectification of deficiencies through surprise random inspection without any prior notice.

The above approval is subject to the fulfilling of the full wing general conditions.

- That the management shall provide adequate funds for development of land and for providing related infrastructural, instructional and other facilities as per norms and standards laid down by the Council from time to time and for menting recurring expenditure
- (a) That the admission shall be made only effect enequate infrastructure and all other radifities are provided as per norths and guicralines of the AICTE.
 - (b) That the admissions shall be made in accordance with the regulations notified by the Council from time to time.
 - (c) That the curriculum of the crurse, the procedure for evuluation/ assessment of students shall be in accordance with the number prencribed by the AICTE.
 - (d) That the Institution shall not allow closure of the Institution or discontinuation of the course(s) or start any new course(s) or alter intelled capacity of seats without the prior approval of the Council.
 - (e) That no excess admission shall be made by the Institution over and above the approved intake under the circumstances, in cast any excess admission is reported to the Council, approvided penul action including Withdrawal of approved shall be intitled against the Institution
 - (f) That the institutions shall not have any collaborative arrangements with any indian and/or Foreign Universities for conduct of technical courses other than those approved by AICTE withour obtaining prior approval from AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall the initiated against the institution.
- (g) That the Institution shall rest conduct any course(s) in the field of technical education in the same pressure as the congress and for in the name of the institution without prior parmission to any entering a section including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution
- (h) The Institution shall not conduct any non-technical course(s) in the same premises/ campus under any circumstances. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal / ction including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution
- 3 That the institution shall operate only from the approval location, and that the institution shall not open any off campus study centeral extension certains directly or in collaboration with any without obtaining prior approval from the PICTE.

- 4 That the tuition and other fees shall ':a charged as prescribed by the Comp stent Authority within the overall criteria prescribed by the Council from time to time. No capitation fee shall be charged from the students/ guardia as of students in any form.
- 5 That the accounts of the Instituti: n shall be audited annually by a certified Chartered Accountant and shall be open for irrespection by the Council or any body or persons authorized by it.
- 6 That the Director/ Principal and the teaching and other staff shall be selected according to procedures, qualifications and experience prescribed by the Council from time to time and pay scales are as per the norms prescribed by the Council from time to time.
 - (a) That the institution shall furnish requisite returns and reports as desired by AICTE in order to ensure proper maintenance of administrative and academic star dards.
 - (b) That the technical institution shall publish an information booklet before commencement of the academic year giving details regarding the institution and courses/ programmes being conducted and details of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. In the form of mandatory disclosure. The information booklet may be made available to the stakeholders of the technical education on cost basis. The mandatory disclosure information shall be put on the institution (Website. The information shall be revised every year with updated information about all aspects of the institution.
 - (c) That it shall be mandatory for the technical institution to maintain a Vebsite providing the prescribed information. The Website information must be continuously undated as and when changes take place.
 - (d) That a compliance report in the prescribed format aking with mandatory disclosures on fulfillment of the above conditions, shall be submitted each year by the institution within the time limit prescribed by the Council from time to time i.e. 31st August 2006 for the current year.
 - (e) That if Technical Institution fails to disclose the Information or suppress and/ or misrepresent the information, appropriate action could be initialed including withdrawal of AICTE approval.
 - 8 That all the laboratories, workshops etc. shall be equipped as per the syllabilor the concerned affiliated University and shall be in operational concition be one making admissions.
 - 9 That a library shall be established with adequate number of titles, books, journals (both Indian & Foreign) etc as per AICTE norms.
 - 10 That a computer center with adequate number of terminals. Primers etc. shall be established as per AICTE norms.
 - 11 AICTE may carry out random inspections round this year for verifying the stress of the Institutions to ensure maintenance of norms and standards.
 - 12 That the AICTF may also conduct inepotions with or without notifying the datas to verify specific complaints of mis-representation, colation of norms and standards, mal-practices etc.
